

Free Lunchtime Con Spirito Concerts

The Con Spirito series of Friday lunchtime concerts, which has been running for almost twenty years, take place in Saint Andrew's Uniting Church on the corner of Ann and Creek Streets in the city. The series is scheduled for the fourth Friday of each month from March to October and is designed to provide mainly tertiary level music students with a performing opportunity different from that offered by their institution. Students from the Queensland Conservatorium (QCGU) and the University of Queensland's School of Music are regular performers in this series. A wide range of music is presented and performers include singers, string players, wind players (both individual and ensembles), pianists and organists. In recent series, groups have included a clarinet trio, saxophone quartet, string orchestra, brass ensemble, wind quintet and opera group. The concerts are free of charge.

Students from the University of Queensland's School of Music will present a music for solo flute and flute ensemble in the **October** Con Spirito concert.

Pieces to be performed include Tango Etude Nos 1 and 3 and Nightclub 1960 by Astor Piazzolla, Duo No. 1 by Friedrich Kuhlau, Flute Quartet by Pierre Max Dubois, Claude Debussy's "Prelude L'apres midi d'une faune" arranged for flute quintet, the 2nd movement from "A Little Night Music" and "Quiet Evening" both by John Carmichael and "Hypnosis" by Ian Clarke. Performers include flautists Nickea Warrener, Anna Coe, Jessica Norup, Cassie Slater, Kurt Schouten and Jo Lagerlow and Samuel Dickenson (piano).
