






ANDY'S PLACE

Andy's Place would like to thank the congregation for their support and assistance in 2024. We could not do what we do for the guests we serve without the many congregation members who give so freely of their time, energy, and funds, to assist those who are struggling to put/keep a roof over their heads, with cost-of-living pressures, or loneliness. There are many needs that we fulfil with the community meal and Andy's shop.

For those who enjoy some facts and figures - in 2024, we regularly served 100 guests for Saturday lunch and 35 guests for Thursday breakfast/morning tea. The cost of the Saturday lunch meal is currently sitting at \$1.66 per meal (which is amazing for the quality and variety our cooks provide) and the Thursday breakfast costs are \$45 per week. We served over 6,000 lunches and 1,500 breakfasts to our guests this year. Total volunteer hours just to provide the 2 meals was over 5,000 hours. At the current minimum wage of \$24.10, if we had to employ staff to provide the service that would represent over \$120,000 per annum!

Our Christmas meal was a sumptuous feast prepared by Andrea's team and enjoyed by a record 120 guests! It is amazing how our food and resources seem to stretch to serve an ever increasing number of guests. In fact, we were so busy we forgot to take pictures of the food, but here a couple of photos showing how festive the hall looked before our guests arrived.

We acknowledge with gratitude the funds/products donated from the social justice table, individual congregation members, and the Lord Mayors Charitable Trust (\$2,900 Christmas grant for food / guest treat bags).

You may be aware that we lost both a fridge and freezer in the lead up to Christmas. Both had been repaired several times recently, so we have ordered new ones, but they will not arrive until 6 January (fridge) and the end of January (freezer). While these were certainly not items we had budgeted on replacing, we were fortunate that we had the funds in our account to go ahead and buy these outright rather than having to wait for appropriate grants to come available. We thank our cooks and supervisors for their ongoing patience and tetris skills in being able to maximise the available food storage space.

We are looking forward to serving our guests again in 2025 and being of service to those who are struggling. The increasing number of guests show that the need is not diminishing!

Thanks again and we look forward to working with you!


